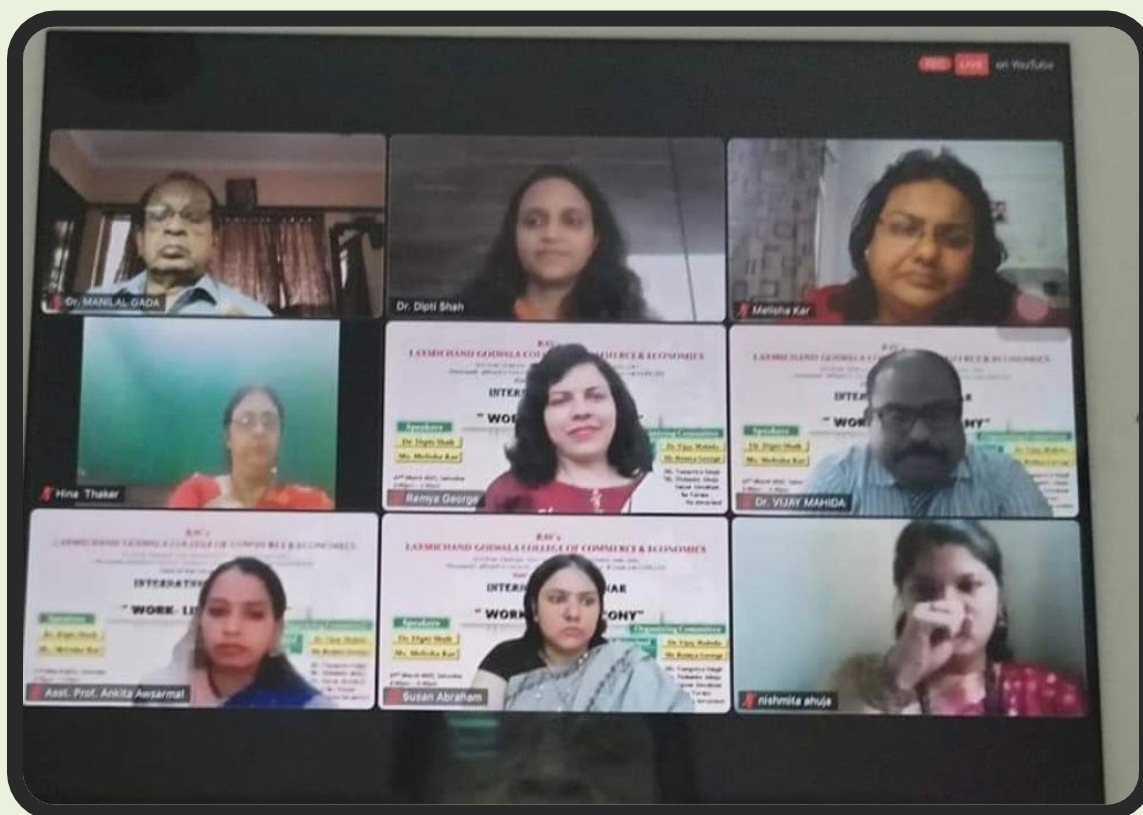
Dr Dipti Shah addressed on Work Life Harmony and Ms Melisha Kar addressed on Work Stress Management.

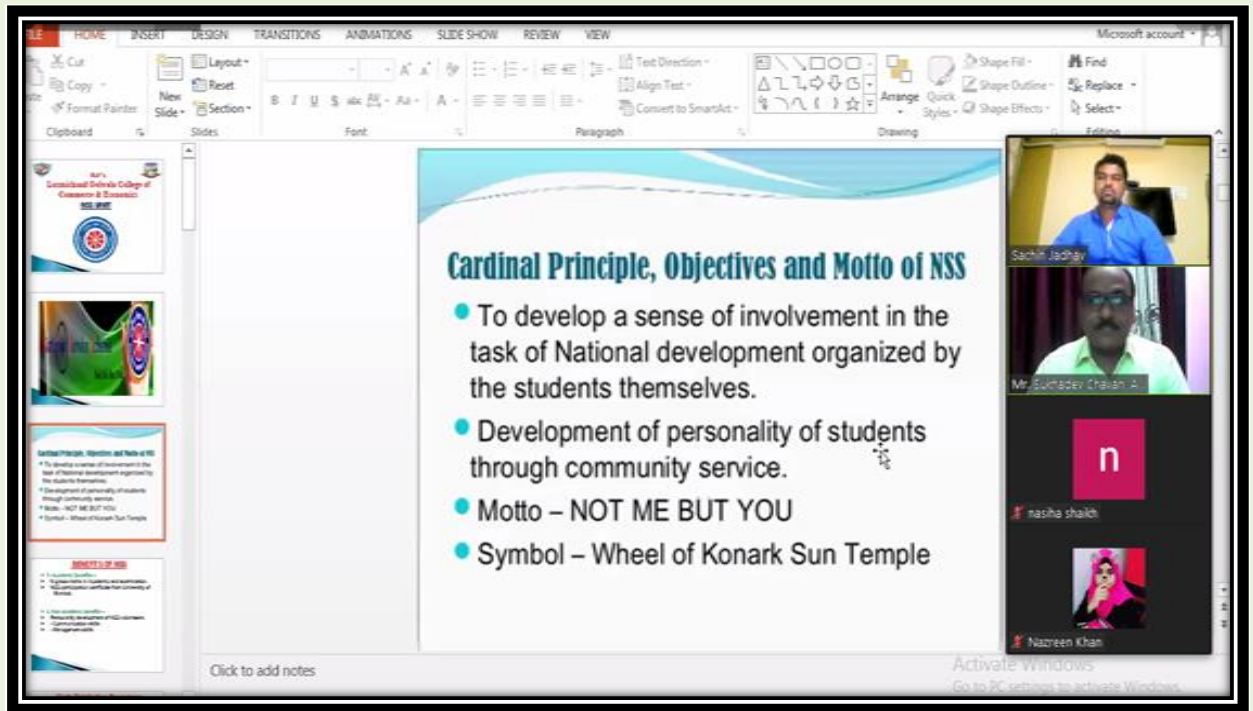
The details about the activities conducted under the NSS unit for this academic year 2020 - 2021 are as follows,

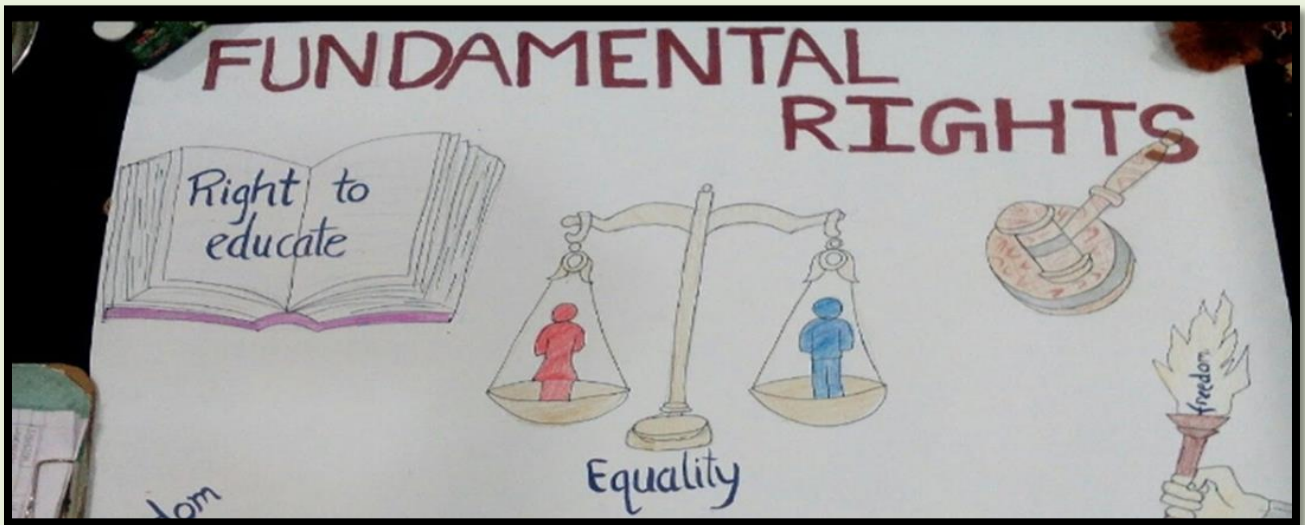
