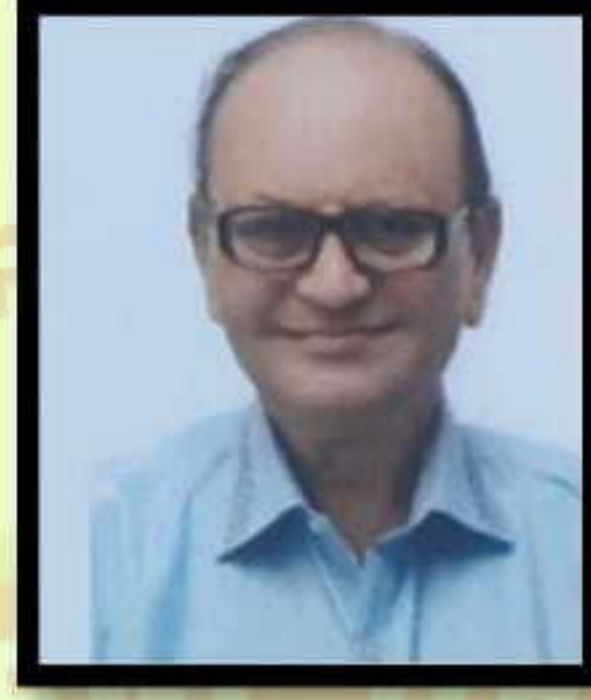

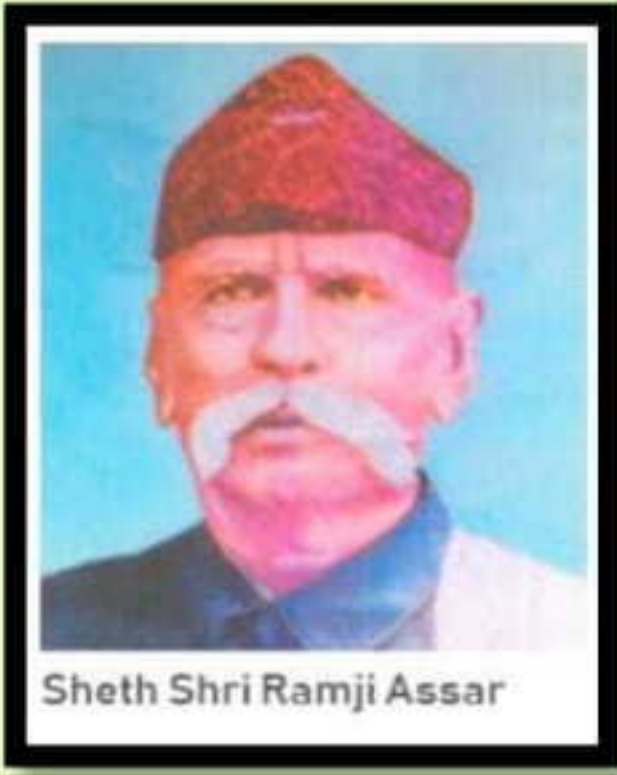

ABOUT COLLEGE



About hundred years ago, Ghatkopar was devoid of any educational institutions. It was Sheth Ramji Assar, the pioneer and visionary, who deemed it necessary to start an educational institute to cater to the needs of the local people. Thus in June 1911 a Gujarati primary co-education school came into existence at Ghatkopar even when education for girls was a taboo.

This college was started by a visionary founder Late Shri. Mansukhlal Vasa (Golwala), a prominent businessman, a well-known exporter and ex-students of Ramji Assar Vidyalaya at the first instant donated Rs. 2,00,00,000/- to the College. The College is named after his Father Shri. Laxmichand Golwala.

Laxmichand Golwala College of Commerce and Economics was started on 15th August, 2009 with 26 students on a permanently non-grant basis. The College has been accredited by NAAC with a 'B' Grade and CGPA of 2.8.

This college was started to cater the needs of higher education and provide affordable education for low-income group. Because of such a foresight, today our college is much sought after for traditional courses as well as specialised courses. Trustee and Managing Committee's innovative ideas have enthused all of us here to keep moving forward by introducing new courses in both PG and UG Sections. Their guidance from time to time has helped college to grow since inception. The mission of our college is to strengthen the students academically, socially and economically. There are today nearly 3500 students in the college. Students are encouraged to take part in all the activities including academics, sports and cultural.

Today the college offers a variety of courses at the Undergraduate and Postgraduate levels of Commerce Streams under the University of Mumbai. The Programmes offered at Undergraduate levels are B.COM, B.COM (Banking & Insurance), B.COM (Accounting & Finance), B.COM (Financial Market), B.COM (Investment Management), B.COM (Transport Management), and Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS) and Postgraduate Programmes such as M.com (Advanced Accounting), M.com (Banking & Finance).

College is preparing for NEP 2020 in big way through multi-disciplinary and inter-disciplinary approach. College has applied for approval to courses like BAMMC (Bachelor of Arts in Multimedia and Mass Communication), B.Sc. in Information Technology, B.Sc. in Computer Science, M. Com in Business Management, B. Com in Business Management, B.A in Economics.

Apart from the regular academic offerings, the college also avails a platform for co-curricular and extracurricular activities for students. College also has IGNOU and YCMOU Centers for different Programmes. The College has come up with new state-of-the-art infrastructure and a fully air-conditioned eight-story building for Laxmichand Golwala College of Commerce and Economics.

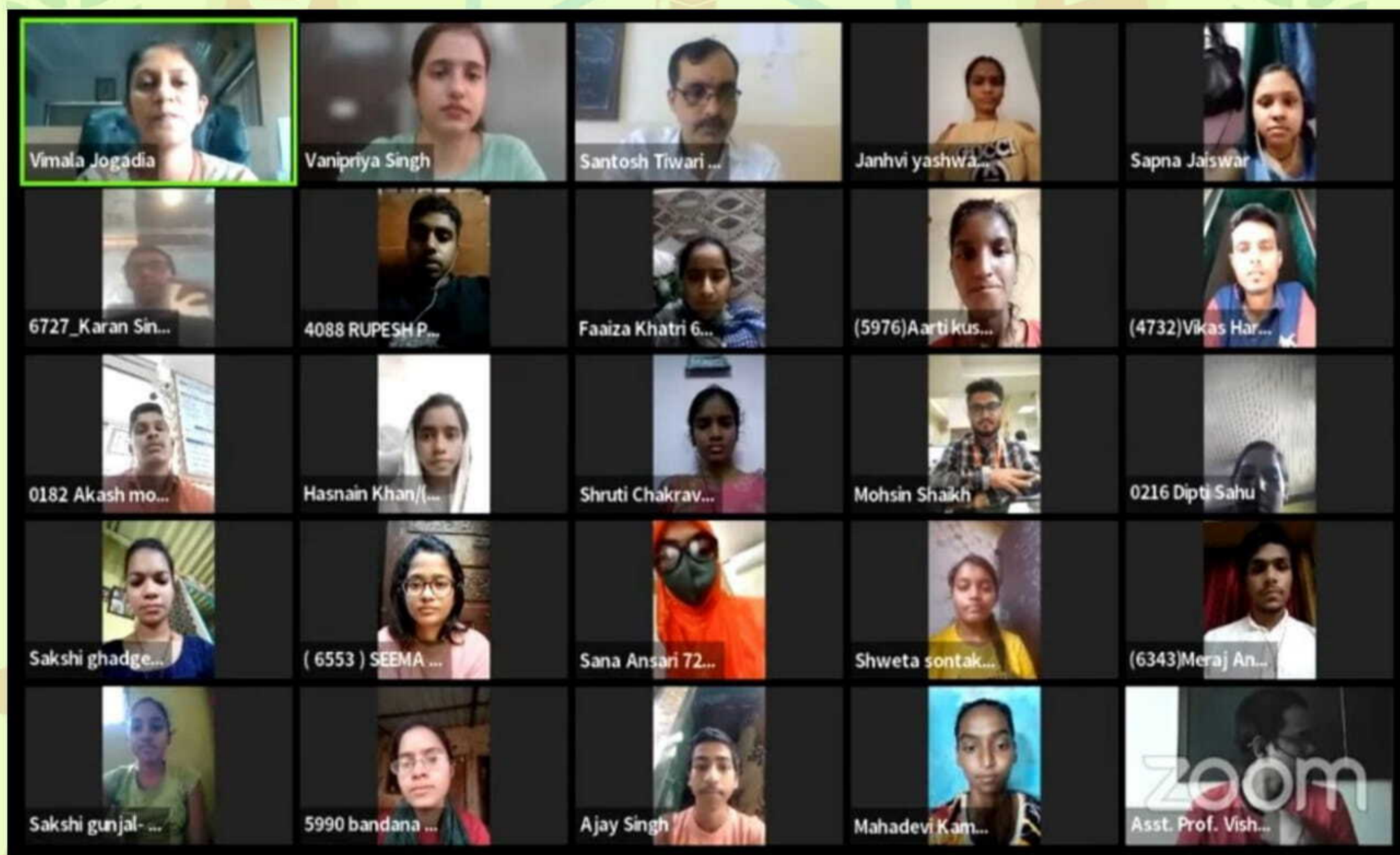
DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTANCY

Below is the list of activities conducted under the Department of Accountancy: -

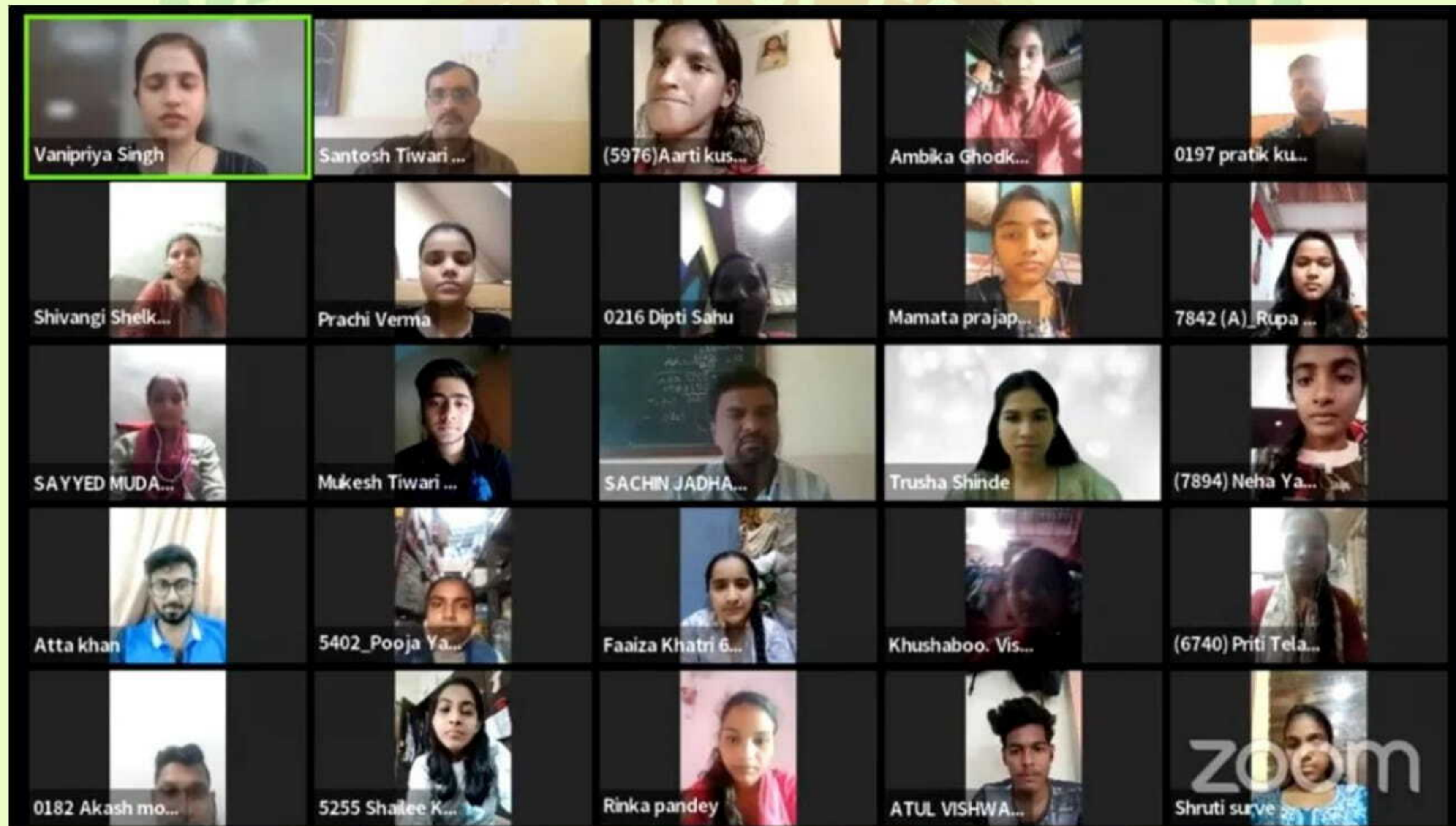
E- return filing

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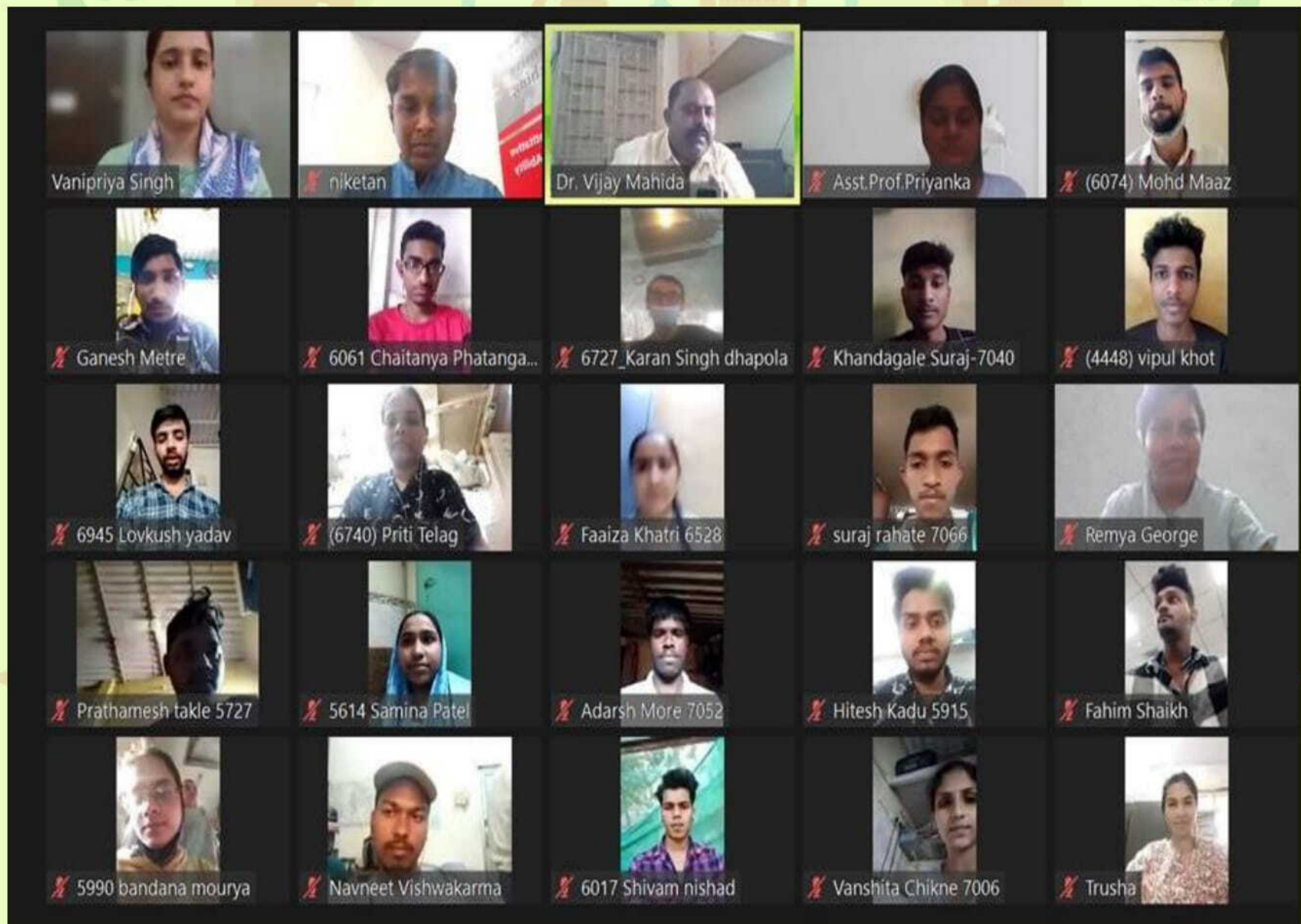
DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

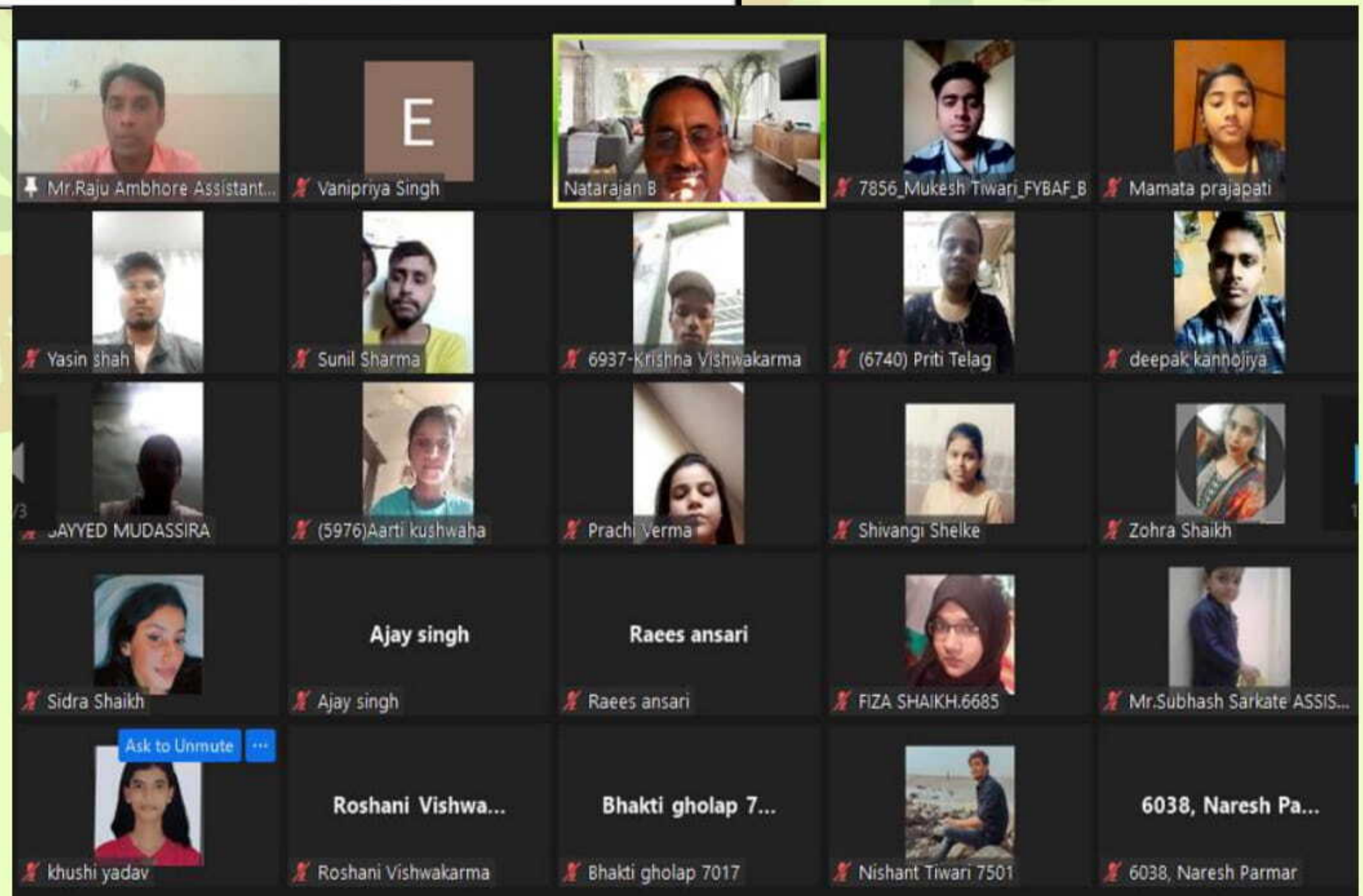
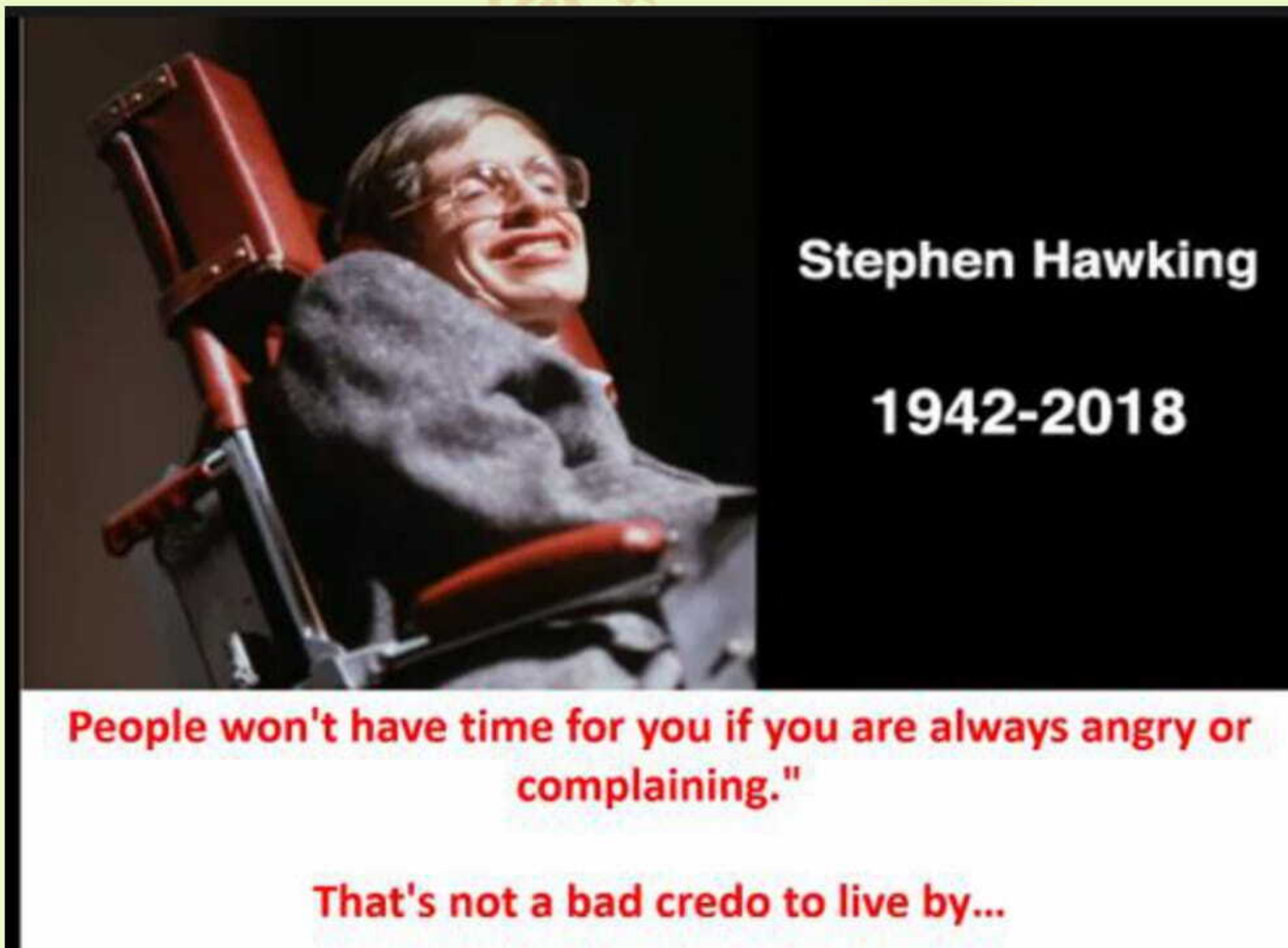
Guest Lecture on Union Budget 2022 -23

Guest Lecture on Skill of using Advance Technology in Banking Transaction

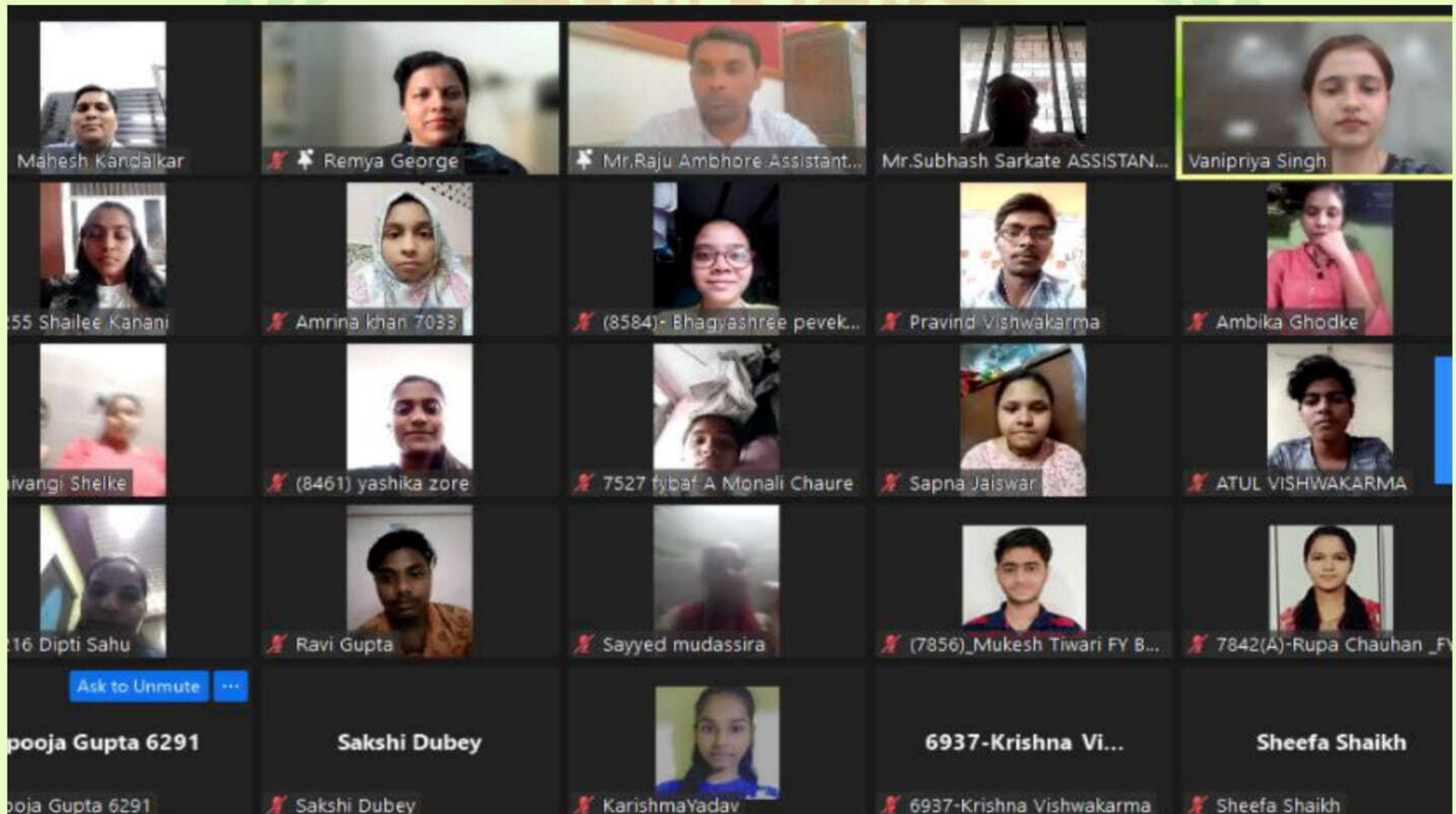

लॉकडाउननंतरचा महाराष्ट्र

माणसाचे जीवन हे कितीतरी संकटाने भरलेलं असतं. माणसाला आपल्या आयुष्यात अनेक खडतर आव्हानांना सामोरे जाऊन आपल्या आयुष्याचा गाडा तसाच चालू ठेवावं लागत. हल्लीच्या काळात असे अनेक प्रसंग उद्भवतात ज्यामुळे माणुस हताश व एकटा पडला जातो. कधी कधी हे सगळं प्रसंग आपल्यालाच का? या प्रश्नाच्या चिंतेमुळे आपली अनेक रात्र विचारात गुंणतवून घेतो. पण खरा माणुस तोच आहे जो निधड्या छातीने ह्या आव्हानाना पार करून जातो आणि सदैव येणाऱ्या परिस्थितिसाठी तयार राहतो. पण काहीवेळा निसर्ग स्वतःच परिक्षा घेण्यासाठी डाव रचतो. तसाच एक प्रसंग हा आपल्यावर उद्भवला होता. तो प्रसंग म्हणजे कोरोना महामारीचा. ह्या विषाणुचा प्रादुर्भाव एवढा भयानक होता की, एकही माणुस ह्याच्यापासून वाचला नाही.

जगाच्या पाठीवर कोरोना नावाचा विषाणू थैमान घालत होता. ह्या विषाणूचा प्रभाव इतका घातक होता की त्याच्यामुळे अनेकांना आपला जीव गमवावा लागला. कित्येक लोकांचे संसार उध्वस्त झाले, तर कित्येकांना आपण ह्याच्यापासून कसा वाचवा आणि कसे स्वतःचे संरक्षण करून घ्यावे ही चिंता सतावू लागली. ह्या विषाणूमुळे अनेक लोक ही मृत्युच्या दारापाशी उभी राहिली व काही जणांना आपला प्राणसुद्धा गमवावे लागले. ह्या सर्व प्रकाराची सुरवात झाली ती सन 2019 च्या शेवटी. चीनच्या वुहान प्रांतातून ह्या विषाणूचा प्रसार सुरु झाला व हळुहळु करून त्याचे वर्चस्व चीन ह्या देशावर दिसू लागले. सुरवातीला साधा वाटणारा हा विषाणू आता अनेक लोकांचे जीव घेऊ लागला होता. ह्या कोरोना विषाणुच्या कचाट्यात अनेक शहर, गाव, वस्ती अडकली गेली. लोकाना मोजता येणार नाही इतक्या पटीने रुग्ण दवाखान्यात उपचारासाठी रांगेत उभी होती. ह्या विषाणूचा प्रसारही वेगात वाढत होता, एका माणसाकडून दुसऱ्या माणसाकडे असा हा प्रवास करत करत पुर्ण चीन हा देश त्याच्या तावडीत अडकला होता. इतक्यावरही न थांबता काही लोकांच्या हलगर्जीपणामुळे ह्या विषाणूने आपली पाउल पुर्ण जगाच्या दिशेने सरसावलं होत. जस जसे दिवस पुढे सरकत होते, तस तसे विविध देशात ह्या विषाणूचे रुग्ण सापडत होते. आता हा विषाणू एखाद्या देशाचा संकट न राहता, एका भयानक जागतिक महामारीचा रूप घेऊ लागला होता. 2019 च्या शेवटच्या दिवसात

प्रत्येक देशात ह्या विषाणूचा रुग्ण तर होताच सोबत ह्या विषाणूंबद्दल चर्चा सुरु होती. ह्या महामारीचे परिणाम एवढे भयानक होते की WHO ह्या संघटनेने गांभीर्याने ह्या विषाणूपासून वाचवण्याचे प्रयत्न सुरू केले गेले.

या विषाणूंच्या जाळ्यात पुर्ण जग अडकत जात होते, त्या विषाणूंपासून आपल्या देशही वाचू शकला नाही. नवीन वर्षाच्या जोश सर्वत्र सुरु असताना ह्या विषाणूने आपली मुळ भारतात पसरायला सुरु केली. एक एक करून देशाच्या विविध भागात कोरोनाचे रुग्ण सापडू लागले होते. आपल्या महाराष्ट्रातसुद्धा बाहेरून आलेल्या प्रवाश्यांमुळे मुंबई, पुण्यासारख्या शहरात कोरोना रुग्ण सापडू लागले होते. जगाच्या तुलनेत आपली रुग्ण संख्या जरी कमी असली तरी ह्याच्या परिणामाचा विचार करून सरकारी यंत्रणा वेळेच्या आधीच आपल्या कामाला सुरवात केली. वेगवेगळ्या प्रकारे कसा ह्या महामारीला थांबवता येईल याचा विचार करून जलद गतीने सरकार पावले उचलत होती. जसे दिवस पुढे सरकत होते तसेच झपाट्याने रुग्णसंख्या वाढत होती, परिस्थिती हाताबाहेर जाण्याच्या आधी काहितरी ठोस निर्णय घेणे गरजेचे होते. अशाप्रकारे सर्व परिस्थितीचा विचार करून देशामध्ये सर्वत्र लॉकडाउन करण्याच निर्णय घेतला गेला. ह्या लॉकडाउन मागे फक्त एकच उद्देश होता की, लोकाना सुरक्षित ठिकाणी ठेवून जसा कमीत कमी लोकांमध्ये ह्या विषाणूंचा प्रसार रोखावे. हतसाच कोणत्याही प्रकारची गर्दी टाळून ह्या विषाणूंचा प्रसार थांबवावा. हा विषाणू मानवी संपर्कातून प्रसार करतो, त्यामुळे ह्या लॉकडाउनमुळे हा संपर्क शक्य तेवढ्या पद्धतीने कमी करता येईल हा प्रयत्न होता.

ह्या सर्व गोष्टींचा विचार करून भारत सरकारने सुरवातीला एक दिवसीय व त्यानंतर मर्यादित काळासाठी संचारबंदी लागू केली. हा लॉकडाउन झाला तर खरा पण, या लॉकडाउनमुळे प्रत्येकाच्या आयुष्यात कमालीचा बदल झाला. ह्या लॉकडाउनच्या प्रभावामुळे अनेक लोकांचे आयुष्य पूर्णपणे बदलून गेले. सुरवातीला अगदी सहज व सोपा वाटणारा हा लॉकडाउन हळु हळु आपल रूप दाखवू लागल. प्रत्येक जण आपापल्या राहत्या घरी बंदिस्त झाला होता. प्रत्येकाला बाहेर मुक्तपणे जाण्यासाठी, फिरण्यासाठी तसेच कोणत्याही गरजेच्या कामासाठी निर्बंध घालण्यात आले होते.. ह्या लॉकडाउनमुळे अनेक लोकांना आपल्या घरात राहणे भाग पाडले तसेच बाहेर जाण्याच्या बंदीमुळे लोकाना पोटापाण्याची व्यवस्था करणे अवघड पडू लागले. ह्या सर्व कारणांमुळे अनेक संसार कोणत्याही आर्थिक गरजा पुर्ण करण्यास असमर्थ झाले. अनेक लोकांनी आपल्या हाताची नोकरी गमावली व अनेक लोकांना आपल्या उदरनिर्वाहासाठी धडपड करावी लागली. कित्येक उद्योग धंदे, दुकान आणि वेगवेगळे व्यवसाय ह्या लॉकडाउनच्या निर्णयामुळे देशोधडीला लागले. कोणत्याही व्यवसायासाठी लागणार मनुष्यबळ हाच आपल्या घरात बंद झाल्यामुळे कोणतेही उद्योग हे आपले काम पार पाडू शकले नाही. ह्याच मनुष्यबळाच्या अभावापायी अनेक उद्योगधंदे ठप्प पडले. तसेच ह्याचाच परिणाम देशाच्या आर्थिक व्यवस्थेवरसुद्धा पडला. अनेक बाजारपेठे हे ग्राहकाच्या अभावापायी सुनसान झाले. तर काही ठिकाणी वस्तूच उपलब्ध नव्हत्या. प्रत्येकजण आपापल्या घरात राहून हलाखीचा जीवन जगत होता. ह्या महामारीच्या आटोक्यात अनेकजण आपला जीव गमवत होते. निर्बंध लादले खरे पण रोगाचा प्रसार काही थांबला नाही. दिवसागणिक रुग्णासंख्या वाढत होती. ह्या वाढत्या रुग्णसंख्येमागे डॉक्टर व आरोग्य कर्मचारी याची संख्या व सुविधा अपुऱ्या पडल्या. रुग्णालयात आत व बाहेर रुग्णाचे लोढा वाहत होता. अनेकांना पुरेशा आरोग्यसेवा सुद्धा उपलब्ध झाल्या नाही. काही माणस दिवसाच्या जगण्यासाठी आवश्यक इतका पैसा ही उभा करू शकत नव्हते. सगळीकडे जनता त्रस्त होऊन बसली होती. हाताला काम नाही, खायला अन्न नाही, गरजेला पुरेल एवढ्या सुविधाही उपलब्ध नाही ह्या सर्व गोष्टींसाठी माणुस उपलब्ध नाही ह्या सर्व गोष्टींसाठी माणुस तडफडत राहिला होता. सगळीकडे दुःखःचे आणि निराशेचे वातावरण पसरत जात होते. आणि त्यात माणुस कसा तरी आपला जीवन जगत होता.

पण बोलतात की प्रत्येक नाण्याच्या दोन बाजू असतात. तसाच ह्या लॉकडाउनमुळे जसे नुकसान झाले, तशाचप्रकारे ह्या लॉकडाउनमुळे अनेक गोष्टीमध्ये सुधारणाही झाल्या. पुर्वी जी माणस आपल्या आरोग्याला डावलून हव तस राहणं हा ज्याचा उपक्रम होता, ते सुद्धा आपल्या आरोग्यासाठी योग्य ते उपाय करू लागले. प्रत्येक जण आपल्या आरोग्याची काळजी घेऊ लागला. त्यामुळे प्रत्येकाचे आरोग्य सुधारू लागले व आपोआप सामाजिक स्वास्थ्य वाढू व सुधारू लागले. पुर्वी ज्या लोकांना आपल्या कामामुळे किंवा उद्योगामुळे आपल्या परिवाराला वेळ देण संभव नव्हता.पण, ह्या लॉकडाउनच्या काळात त्यांना

आपला पुर्ण वेळ आपल्या माणसांना देणे शक्य झाले. अनेक लोक आपल्या परिवारासोबत आनंदाचे क्षण साजरे करू लागले. ह्या सान्याच परिणाम म्हणून अनेकांचे नाते सुधारू लागले व परिवारात परिवारिकसंबंध घट्ट होऊ लागले. अनेक मुलांना आपल्या आई वडिलांच्या सानिध्यात राहण्याची संधी प्राप्त झाली. फक्त एवढाच नाही तर या लॉकडाऊनच्या काळात आरोग्य यंत्रणेमध्ये खुप बदल झाले. कित्येक ठिकाणी आरोग्य सेवेमध्ये आरोग्य अधिकारी आणि सुविधांमध्ये कमालीची वाढ होऊ लागली. पुर्वीच्या क्षमतेपेक्षा दुप्पट रुग्णाचा उपचार एकाच वेळी करणे शक्य झाले.

ह्या लॉकडाऊनमुळे सर्व प्रकारची शाळा व महाविद्यालये ही बंद पडली होती आणि कोणालाही प्रत्यक्ष शाळेत जाणे शक्य नव्हते. अशावेळी अनेक ठिकाणी ऑनलाइन पद्धतीने शिक्षणास सुरवात झाली. अनेक विद्यार्थी आपल्या राहत्या जागी शिक्षणाची सुविधा घेऊ लागली. त्यामुळे शैक्षणिक यंत्रणेलाही चालना मिळाली. अनेक ठिकाणी आधुनिक शैक्षणिक पद्धतीचा वापर करून विद्यार्थ्यांना शिकवणे सुरू केले गेले. आधुनिक माध्यमाचा वापर फक्त शिक्षणाही कोणत्याही अडथळ्याशिवाय सुरू राहिले. ह्या आधुनिक पद्धतीचा वापर फक्त शिक्षणातही नाही तर बाकी अनेक ठिकाणी उपयोग करून त्याच्या सुविधा अजून जलद करण्यात आल्या. याच आधुनिक सेवेचा वापर करून अनेक लोकांना आपल्या आर्थिक गरजा भागविण्यासाठी पर्याय उपलब्ध झाला.

ह्या लॉकडाऊनच्या काळात वाहतुकीच्या व दळणवळणाच्या सुविधाही काही प्रमाणात कमी झाल्या होत्या, त्याच्या परिणाम असा झाला की, याच लॉकडाऊनच्या काळात प्रदुषणाचीही बाधा कमी झाली होती. ह्या लॉकडाऊनमध्ये मुंबईत परिसरात आणि मोठमोठ्या अश्या अनेक शहराचे वातावरण शुद्ध आणि प्रदुषणविरहित झाले होते. ह्या सगळ्यामुळे हे सिद्ध झाले की, लॉकडाऊननंतर जरी नुकसान झाले तरी महाराष्ट्राने या परिस्थितीचा फायदा घेऊन अनेक बदल करून घेतले. याच काळात सामाजिक, वैयक्तिक आणि आर्थिक ह्या क्षेत्रातही महाराष्ट्राने खुप बदल घडवून आणले.
