











1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 927 responses



Analysis: The above diagram clearly shows that 44.7% of the students feel that 70 - 84% portion has been completed, 28.9% have selected that more than 85% of the portions has been completed. Only 1.5% respondents felt that below 30% portions was completed.


2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 927 responses


3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

Analysis: 59.1% of the students felt that the teachers were able to communicate effectively and 2.7% felt that teacher's communication was very poor.


4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 927 responses



Analysis: 33.7% and 32.3 % of the students felt that teacher's approach to teaching is very good and excellent respectively. 0.8% felt that approach is very poor.


5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

Analysis: 53.5 % and 31.2 % of the students felt that internal evaluation process is always and usually fair respectively. 1% felt that this process is unfair.


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 927 responses


7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students


8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.


9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

Analysis: 59.1% of the students agree and 3.8% of them strongly disagree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.


10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.



Analysis: 39.7 % of the students usually feel and 802 % rarely feel that their mentor dos a necessaryfollow-up with an assigned task to you.


12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.


Analysis: 45 % Students have selected usually and 20.7% have selected every time and 3.6 % students have selected never on teachers illustrating the concept through examples and applications


14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them. 927 responses

15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.



16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.



17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
