HIGHLIGHT OF ANNUAL REPORT A.Y. 2023-2024

- This academic year is a milestone in the history of the college because it has shifted to a new state of the art infrastructure, a fully air-conditioned eight storey building.
- The college got permission to start B.Sc. IT, B.Sc. CS, BAMMC, BA, M.Com. (Business Management). We got an overwhelming response in B.Sc. IT and B.Sc. CS. We have applied for additional divisions for B.Sc. IT and B.Sc. CS, as well as the new programme. B.Sc. Data Science for the A.Y. 2024-25. It means from a single faculty of commerce, now we are into arts and science education as well. It shows that we are now a multidisciplinary educational institution and getting closer to the goal of NEP 2020.
- College has organised Research Paper Presentation Competition with the theme spotlighting 'Marketing Strategies in the Digital Age: Leveraging Social Media' where more than 12 colleges with 50 students' participants
- In the Avishkar Research Conclave of the University of Mumbai, 35 students participated, the highest till date. And most important, this year for the first time, our project title, "Toilet Entrepreneurship: Venture out of Waste," is selected for the second round.
- This year, more than 50 students participated in various intercollegiate competitions and won the top three prizes. We won the Best College Award at Ramniranjan Jhunjhunwala College. Also won prizes at Sinhgad Institute, Burhani College, Gyanodaya College, Sathe College, Gurunanak College, etc. Students participated in competitions like Mehendi, Rangoli, one minute talent, treasure hunt, digital games, and Power Point Presentations.
- In extension activity DLLE, this year we have the highest enrolment of 192 students. Students also won various prizes in DLLE competitions organised by the university and other colleges.
- The NSS unit organised 40 events and also successfully completed 7 days residential camp in a village near Titwala.
- The college has organised 108 activities, including more than 30 guest sessions, more than 10 workshops, and various programs with MOU partners.
 The college has started an initiative called 'YOUVA KATTA" giving

- students the opportunity to showcase their talent every week apart from sports, cultural fest, various competitions, etc.
- o In A.Y. 2023-24 College has entered into twelve MOUs with Symbiosis Centre for Distance Learning Institute, IGNOU, Indian Merchant Chambers, Board of Industry Academia Partnership, Ambition Learning Solutions, Asian School of Cyber Law, Beam Outsourcing Services, Swayam Siddha Foundation, Akshara Foundation, Connect For etc. and a few MOUs are under discussion with Brahma Kumari's and BAPS Swaminarayan Sanstha.
- o It is proud to share that our principal, Dr. Sunil Karve is re-appointed by University of Mumbai as Chairman, BOS in Banking and Insurance, and another BOS in Investment Management. Also. In this academic year, he has received 3 patents, of which one is registered in UK and published one book with Canadian publication.
